
Electronic Statement Notification Agreement

This disclosure governs, along with any other documents applicable to this account including the Credit Union's Electronic Funds Transfer Agreement and Membership Account Agreement, the agreement between the member and Extra Credit Union regarding receiving periodic statements electronically. The member acknowledges that a printed periodic statement will no longer be mailed to the member. If, at any time, the member decides that he/she no longer wants to receive the periodic statement(s) electronically and wants to resume receiving a printed copy of the periodic statement, the member must complete the cancellation request online for such action to be taken. It is understood that any actions that are to be taken by the Credit Union under this Agreement will not be taken until the Credit Union has had a reasonable opportunity to act upon such actions.

The periodic statement(s) will be available through the Online Account Access system via the Internet. An electronic mail (e-mail) notification will be sent to the address shown below when the statement(s) are available for viewing. The member who receives this e-mail is the agent for his/her joint owners for the purpose of receiving and notifying them that the statement(s) is available. The member must notify the Credit Union within 30-days after receiving the e-mail notification of any discrepancies. If the member fails to notify the Credit Union, the member will have no claim against the Credit Union. However, if the discrepancy is the result of an electronic funds transfer, the provisions of the Credit Union's Electronic Funds Transfer Agreement will control this resolution. If the undersigned does not receive an e-mail from the Credit Union because he/she failed to supply the Credit Union with a correct e-mail address, the Credit Union will send the notification via U.S. Mail. Once a proper e-mail address has been supplied to the Credit Union via the online system, notifications will resume via e-mail. The member agrees that the Credit Union is not liable to the member if the member is unable to access the e-mail site or download the statement to a printer. (1-2003)

The member acknowledges that a periodic statement(s) will no longer be sent to him/her by U.S. Mail and that he/she will need access to the Online Account Access system via the Internet, an e-mail account and Adobe Acrobat reader software in order to have access to the statement electronically. Adobe Acrobat reader software is available to download from the credit union's web site at ExtraCreditUnion.org free of charge.

By entering an e-mail address and accepting the electronic statement registration form online, the member agrees to be bound by the terms stated in this agreement. (1/2003)
