The information at the top is your basic transaction information like date, time, account number, account type, etc. The receipt is going to explain exactly what you did during your transaction.

The headers, indicated above with the red arrows, explain exactly what Kim did step-by-step. Kim arrived at the teller line and gave \$100 cash to the teller. The teller then deposited the \$100 cash into her checking account. (The information listed under the date, tells you that the teller is in her checking account.) The total deposit into checking is \$100. Her current balance is \$103.87.

The new receipts do not show previous balances like our old receipts. We can only assume that Kim's previous balance was \$3.87.
