Internet Security Measures

Your information is scrambled. This technology called Secure Socket Layers (SSL) protects information you submit or receive through this site. No representation is made, however, regarding the unconditional security of such submissions.

Credit Union-Approved Browsers

Our credit union requires that your browser supports SSL, and does not allow information to be stored on your hard drive unless you specifically download it and save it on your computer.

Firewall

Extra Credit Union uses firewalls to help limit entry by anyone without proper authorization. A firewall is a security mechanism that regulates the data going in and out of a network. It is a commonly used, specialized computer, which acts as a shield against data going in or out of a network. It checks to make sure that communications only occur between approved individuals and that the communication is in the proper protocol.

Constant Surveillance

Extra Credit Union's security systems regularly monitor the web server to help ensure your information is secure.
