Eligibility Requirements

Extra Credit Union will grant up to five (5) Continuing Education Scholarships (totaling \$5,000) to individuals who graduated high school more than one year ago or nontraditional students who are returning to school after a hiatus. There are no age limitations for qualification. Those who meet the following criteria may apply:

- 1. Applicants must be a member of Extra Credit Union at the time of application. *
- 2. Applicants must be pursuing their education at an accredited institution, trade school, vocational school, community college or university.
- 3. Applicants must be accepted by the school and plan to be enrolled, at minimum, as a part-time student (6 credit hours).

Community & School-Related Involvement

Attach a document to complete the following:

Make a list of your involvement in school-related and/or community activities and volunteer programs. Please include dates/years involvement and/or hours completed. Please feel free to include involvement details, such as specific tasks performed and/or any concluding thoughts or impressions of the activities or programs.

Two Letters of Recommendation

The written recommendations can be from a past or present employer, coach, teacher, instructor, counselor, community leader, etc., but must be written by an unrelated adult. The letter should be recent, signed and address why the applicant deserves the scholarship, as well as elaborate the applicant's character and accomplishments.

Resumé

Include an updated, typed copy of your resumé. Resumés will be reviewed similar to a resumé being considered for employment.

Essay

Selection criteria will include: ideas/content, organization, sentence fluency, word choice and grammar. The essay should be 250-500 words, typed, double spaced in 12 pt. font.

Essay Topic

What difference do you want to make in the world and how does your career choice help you make a difference in the world?

Applications must be submitted by June 27, 2025. Late applications will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be considered. 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The scholarship recipient will be notified by July 31, 2025. This scholarship is available for tuition, books and fees. At Extra Credit Union's discretion, the scholarship will be paid directly to the educational institution the student is attending.
